

Saturday **January 27**th 9 am-4pm Advanced Inkle weaving with Annie MacHale *Horizontal Bar Background Pickup*

Annie is from Santa Fe NM and is an international instructo who has written three books on inkle weaving and designs inkle belts and straps for many well- known musicians.

February 10, 2024, 9:30am - 4:30pm Spinning Cotton Off the Point....with Joan

This class will include spinning off the book charkhas, takli, quill spinning wheels, including the electric wheel and even the great wheel. This class is for spinners who feel comfortable with their wheel but want to explore the thrill of spinning off the point of a quill. Cotton will be used in this class but any short staple fiber like camel down or cashmere can be spun off the point of charkha wheels. Charkhas of many types will be available in class, but we welcome you to bring YOUR charkha or quill wheel to class. Limited enrollment. Material fee; \$10



February 16 9:30-4:30 Basic Beginning & Refresher Class

Lynn Ruggles will be teaching the fundamentals of spinning on a wheel. This is a great class for both the beginner and those who need a refresher course.

Learn how your spinning wheel works and how to adjust it to spin the yarn that you want. This class will teach you the parts of a wheel, and how they all work together. You will learn how to control your wheel and drafting to give you an even yarn in bulky, medium and fine weights. You will also learn how to ply your singles, wind the yarn off the wheel and wash it to make a finished yarn. Material fee: \$10

February 21-22 9:30-4:30 Cotton Spinning Made Easy

This class is a basic introduction to cotton spinning and is designed to give the spinner an understanding of both cotton and how and why to adjust their wheel for this fine, short staple fiber. Students will learn how to card and make punis from ginned cotton as well as blending dyed lint for creating designer yarns. Learning first the techniques of spinning cotton from a puni, students will move on to spinning from the cotton boll to spinning from sliver. Plying and finishing their skeins of yarns. Material fee: \$30
